Conference Action 2008

The goal was to have each church paying its true fair share of FMCNA home ministries by 2013. The disparity of what was paid in 2008 and what should have been paid is being adjusted approximately 20% (up or down) annually for 5 years until the fair share for each church is reached. Twenty-six churches (in bold) will be paying their fair share in 2010. The others are continuing to be adjusted.

The conference is assessed 3.2% of the net income for each church as reported in the year-end financial reports. Net income is the total income of the church minus funds given for FM World Missions (budget), capital funds, bequests, church planting gifts, auxiliary ministries such as Christian schools, church planting funds and any "pass through" gifts that do not benefit the local church.

Wabash Conference Board of Administration action on December 17, 2009

Because of the 2008 action (above) 12 churches have been overpaying their FMCNA Home Ministries Fair Share in order to assist the 38 churches that were underpaying on their Fair Share through the 5 year adjustment period. The Board of Finance was able to reduce the 2010 Conference Budget and it was voted that the savings from these reductions be put in the FMCNA Home Ministries Fair Share budget so that the 12 churches would not continue to overpay. Their new amounts are indicated above in dark blue.
